

Garden Maintenance Crew Leader

Job Description:

Crew leaders are responsible for the work completed by their crew in the field. This involves leading your crew to complete the assigned work and being the point-person for clients on the job site. Work must be completed efficiently with attention to detail and client expectations. Crew leaders are expected to be courteous, helpful, and positive in their relationships with clients and fellow employees.

In the field, garden crew leaders are expected to complete garden maintenance tasks such as weeding, pruning, dead heading, leaf/plant debris removal, and watering. Additional tasks include installing irrigation, weed mat, and mulch. Crew leaders will also be asked to utilize small-engine equipment such as leaf blowers, hedgers, and weed whips, as well as drive work trucks to job sites.

Our garden crew leaders have a seasonal schedule that runs from Mid April to November. We also offer snow removal work for those interested in working year-round. We encourage current or former MSU students to apply and we're happy to work around university schedules.

- Ability to work well with people!
- Ability to show up on time at 7:15am
- Strong communication skills with teammates and clients
- Ability to work outside in various weather conditions, stand or sit for extended periods, and lift up to 50lbs
- Valid driver's license with clean driving record
