- letter of references with a minimum of one from a 4-H Leader and a minimum of one from a person outside of 4-H.
- summary/resume of your 4-H accomplishments (i.e. projects, awards, trips, events, activities, etc.) and school activities.

The complete scholarship application packet must <u>arrive</u> (<u>not</u> postmarked) at the Flathead County Extension Office **no later than 4:30 pm Monday, March 31, 2025.**
