4-H ENROLLMENT POLICY UPDATE: Our county 4-H program enrollment policy has been updated and our enrollment window will **OPEN** October 1st and **will now CLOSE January 15th** (previously March 1st) – which means ALL youth and volunteers **MUST** be enrolled in 4-H and any/all projects they plan to participate in no later than January 15th, **especially** if planning to participate in the **Fair** in that project area. Please note: some Projects have enrollment caps and/or tagging deadlines and may close **prior** to January 15th.
