- Faculty senate purpose
  - Chief governance body of the faculty of MSU
  - FS has authority to frame policies, procedures, standards in Faculty Handbook which...foster a climate of academic freedom; promote consistency in tenure, promotion in academic rank, workload, and salary; uphold academic standards, and uphold standards and procedures of accountability concerning faculty ethics and responsibilities.
  - FS provides a means for **faculty and administration to interact** and discuss University business including strategic planning, budgeting, curriculum, accreditation, and graduation requirements



#### Faculty may develop policies that promote, among other things

- Effective and efficient use of University resources;
- General economic well being of faculty;
- Professional faculty development;
- Quality educational resources such as libraries, facilities, laboratories, and equipment; and,
- Optimal learning environments.



#### Legally outside of our charter

- Explicit political condemnation or support
  - Example: Using email to support a specific policy or candidate, using position to explicitly discourage support for a specific policy or candidate

#### On topic

- Academic freedom
- Inappropriate interference with our educational or research mission



#### On Retaliation

- Statistically unlikely, however...
- Can be difficult to identify
- All members of our community should
  - Be aware of potential retaliation
  - Publicly stand against retaliation
