- 2. Background: your motivation for the proposed work, rationale for why the project is important and how it will enhance the Student Fellow's development and benefit Texts and Critics students and/or the Honors College as a whole, and description of any work completed to date.
- 3. Project description.
- 4. Project timeline: key milestones with target dates for each.
- 5. Advising plan: frequency of meetings, draft submittals, etc.
- 6. Deliverable(s): Product(s) you will submit at project completion.

The Student Fellow should submit their proposal <u>by the 15th day of classes</u>, and attain approval by the 5th week of the semester including any revisions which may be required. All work must be completed and final deliverable(s) submitted by the last day of classes.
